#### The Saline Summer Camp. Six weeks with the boys and girls of Penna

Active during the months of July and August "The Saline Summer Camp" of Penna San Giovanni took place with great participation of all the children who are the focal points of these six weeks spent together. This year the communal administration, in collaboration with the Cultural Association Colucci, despite all the problems posed by Covid 19, wanted to organise the summer camp for the children of our community, and others, in compliance with anti-covid regulations. The home of the summer camp was in the splendid framework of the wonderful Saline park of Penna San Giovanni where, as well as being together, the children had the opportunity to immerse themselves in nature and to be able to

### The church of "Madonna Delle Grazie" reopen for worship

The communal administration, lead by mayor Stefano Burocchi, has restored for worship the Church of The Assumption of Mary, known as "Chiesa delle Grazie", not only a dear and sacred place for the citizens of Penna San Giovanni but above all a place rich in history and significance for the entire religious community, which reminds us of the old church of the Franciscan Brothers, of Blessed John, and of many parts of our history.

After years of abandonment and neglect, due to earthquake, the communal administration decided to carry out numerous works to repair the church and return it to the faithful.



Even though it was not the original place where Blessed John, among the first followers of Saint Francis, had spent a significant part of his life, this place still plays a fundamental role in the life of the village.

Works have been carried out to repair the roof of the main building and the insulation of the belfry which had been damaged by weather, the works have brought the structure back to usable status and have allowed this precious building to be returned to the community. There then followed all the final works, such as the painting of the internal walls and the repaving of the marble floor, returning the value and energy to the history of this church. The opportunity has also been taken to restore the external garden restoring a more healthy and sacred aspect to the whole building.

#### With the "TeatrOpera Festival" Opera descends on the piazza

The project, financed by the Regione Marche, involved 8 communities of the Unione Montana Monti Azzurri, to which has also been added the commune of Penna San Giovanni.

## Spirituality of the earth: 18th Conference

The regular appointment at Penna San Giovanni, organized by the Association Colucci, turns eighteen this year and "Begins to walk the world on its own two feet ". This is how on the 4th of October the conference "From the earth and from human work" was greeted, conceived and coordinated by Don Paolo Bascioni, president of the Association Colucci, who crossed territorial borders this year thanks to new technology. allowing contributions from all over Italy via the Zoom platform coordinated by engineer Giacomo Sufferini. A room packed beyond all expectations considering the restrictions due to Covid along with several participants connected online, carefully followed the various speakers. After a welcome from mayor Stefano Burocchi,



the conference was introduced by Don Paolo telling how, since publication in 2000 of a book of reflections on the relevance in the present day of the message of St.Francis, sprang the idea of organising a conference on the theme: "from the earth and from the work of man ", which has been repeated every year with the in-depth study of different perspectives, from legal to philosophical, to ethics and solidarity. The first conference in 2003 dealt with the topic: "The land for life or the land for profit? ". This year, for the eighteenth conference the topic was the "Spirituality of the Earth" with a short online greeting the coordinator of the event, Roberto Brioschi, ruralist and researcher, introduced the topic and the speakers: Fra Giulio Criminesi; Prof.



Carlo Alberto Graziani, university professor, former president of the Sibillini Park and member of the committee Rodotà; the writer, jurist and Italian academic Ugo Mattei; the journalist and writer Paolo Cacciari and Antonio Lo Bello president of the committee "Fa la cosa Giusta Sicilia". There was much food for thought in anticipation of the volume that, as per tradition, will be collated in the prospective for the next meeting.

## **Public Works**

#### **TOWN HALL**

Following the assessment of earthquake damage, the relocation of the old municipal archive to the ground floor of the Casa di Riposo P.Burocchi and the reopening of the west wing of the ground floor, current location of the post office, the formal process continues to bring back to function the historic Town Hall of the commune of Penna San Giovanni. Planning for earthquake reinforcement works for the whole building, for which have been approved

€1,050,000, will be set by the end of this year.

So, little by little, pieces of hope and reality are added to restore to the entire community the splendour of one of the symbolic palazzos of this village.



#### THE THEATRE

Unfortunately the pandemic which has hit and continues to hit the whole world has brought a hard slow-down to the works planned for the commune's theatre. The works which were planned to begin in March 2020 and to be completed in November 2021 have been delayed by about a year. The administration is doing the impossible and hopes have not changed: the investment of €340,000, made up of European funds, from Fesr, is still available. However, we close this year with a hope for 2021. In the first months of the new year the tender process for the works will begin, thanks to the successful receipt of approvals from the Province and the Superintendent, hoping for the return of the theatre back to the Penna community in November 2022. Its rebirth will be seen through works planned to re-establish the usability of the part of the structure that was damaged by earthquakes, the improvement of toilet facilities and with a new fire security system, with the addition of a new emergency exit stairway and the replacement of curtains and seats with fire-resistant material.



#### THE SCHOOL

2020 had the fortune to see completed the works at the state school G. Pascoli. The participation in the Band "0-6 years" of the Minister of Instruction of the University and Research has allowed the installation of antifire security in the whole school and the renewal of the old emergency stairs in order to comply with all current antifire regulations. The other target to be hit by the administration was without doubt the repair of all the external flooring of the school, the open area inside the garden, up to the remaking of the road surface in the carpark and the area in front of the main entrance. However the works were not limited to only the functional aspects of the school, but also had regard to the children nearby; in fact an external play area has also been created for the little ones where they can play and learn at the same time with multifunctional panels and a sandbox. Soon there will also be installed some sunshade covers to filter the sun's rays and allow the smallest to play even during the most sunny days.



### VIDEOSURVEILLANCE EQUIPMENT

The installation of the video surveillance system has been completed: the necessity arose from the need to increase the control over our neighbourhood with the use of technological devices to support the work of the police. A further call for tenders is currently underway to expand the new camera system, thus encompassing a wider range of the entire Penna neighbourhood.

#### WIFI4EU

The work enabled thanks to the award of the European initiative Wifi4EU to install a wireless line in Penna is completed. The work has facilitated the connection to a public Wifi system at various points in the village. The various connection points are located inside some public places and in strategic locations in the village: Largo Garibaldi near the bus stop, Saline park, Monte park near the Chalet and in the places in front of the medical centre by the Casa di Riposo P.Burocchi. A free service that the commune has always wanted to provide for the whole population of Penna San Giovanni and to tourists who visit our village and admire its wonders every year.

## **Public Works**

#### Funding: € 200,000 for the former Colonia and the former GdF Barracks

Plans are being submitted for the newly allocated Earthquake 2020 funding.

Penna San Giovanni misses nothing and has quickly seized the opportunity to make sure of interventions on the territory according to the rule of the Vitruvian triad: Utilitas - Venustas - Firmitas, that is, Utility - Beauty - Solidity.

These are the objectives that have always been pursuits of the Burocchi Administration and these are the elements underlying the two projects funded: the Ex-Colonia of Parco Monte and the former barracks of the Guardia di Finanza of Saline Park.

The first project aims to renovate the property and the surrounding area.

We will proceed step by step: first, by the end of this year, the exterior design to restore decorum and welcome to the surrounding spaces, embracing all the potential of these places, symbols and landmarks for the countryside of Macerata;



then it will move into one phase following the restructuring of the whole ground floor and part of the first floor, where six more apartments will be housed in addition to those already in existence, equipped with all the necessary comforts. In fact, all the apartments will be prepared with a laundry area and all rooms will overlook the outside so as to benefit the well-being and comfort of those who live there.

The second half of the 2020 budget aims at renovating another large building of great potential. The project involves securing the roof of the former barracks of the Guardia di Finanza, deteriorated by the weather conditions that are characteristic of the area along the Salino stream. The kitchen areas will be updated, bathrooms will be improved, finishing works will then follow.

The goal is to make the entire structure more functional, creating multipurpose spaces, to be used in the various activities that will follow over the next few years.



#### **EX HOTEL**

Works are in progress on the ex-hotel "Acque Minerali" in Contrada Saline to create four separate units. The structure, damaged by earthquakes and now under reconstruction, will be available next summer to house families displaced by the earthquakes of 2016-2017. A step forward for the administration which quickly gave priority to the health of its citizens, despite this not being one of the most rosy periods and which has been put even more to the test by the health crisis. However, the works are halfway there with completion planned for June 2021, to then be able to welcome the return of inhabitants and return life to the whole structure.

#### SMS SOLIDALI - CASA DI RIPOSO

With generous national financing, achieved with small donations of the so-called SMS Solidali ,work has been completed to modernise one of the two lifts as well as to install a video-surveillance system both internally and externally. Now the Casa di Riposo ends the year with a brighter outlook, ending with a final work to refit the laundry area.

#### THE HISTORIC LOGGIA - CEMETERY

Finally something is moving! Indeed at the beginning of 2021 it is envisaged that the project will be assigned for the repairs of the historic loggia of the cemetery of Penna San Giovanni.

The ancient part has still not been reopened, in spite of the works to make it safe that were done in 2018 following the cracks in the structure reported after the earthquakes that hit this area. The funding amount has recently been set at €575,000 and soon what seems to be an ever more distant challenge will seem closer and more concrete

#### **CEMETERY CHAPELS**

Renovation work has been completed on the recovering of the cemetery chapels of the eastern block, the most recently extended section of the Civic Cemetery. The emergency due to the penetration of rain and snow now seems a distant memory. Although the work was subject to numerous unforeseen events, the Works Management together with the whole team was immediately able to resolve all the problems: the entire substrata of the roof has been removed and refitted, using adequate waterproofing, new flooring has been installed, restoring beauty and décor to the new wing of the Penna San Giovanni Cemetery.

#### **SERVICE STATION**

Work continues on the most anticipated project in recent years, the fuel station. 2020 ends with the authorisation phase of the plan; in fact, the clearance from the Fire Brigade and the Aua are expected soon. The next step will be the tendering process which should lead to works beginning in May 2021 and end with the commissioning of the entire plant by the end of summer 2021. An important step for this village, which has been without it for years.

#### PILOTTI CHURCH

The safety measures for the Church of San Giuseppe, in Contrada Pilotti, have been completed. The project provided for the installation of a temporary cover to repair it and protect the assets inside the Church. Spring 2021 should bring good news for the property owned by the Archdiocese of Fermo, it is planned, in fact, to grant the design of the reconstruction of the Church in the months of March - April 2021.

#### **CAMPER AREA**

The area of the former tennis court has been chosen to be used for tourism, the design plan has been completed, additions have been made; all that remains is to contract out the works for an amount of €150,000 financed by earthquake funding, which are expected for spring 2021. As a matter of fact, the new Camper area will be ready and usable as early as next summer.

#### **PORTARELLA**

The Portarella has been a symbol of reconstruction for months. The commitment of individuals, namely the Portarella Committee is synonymous with union, sharing, harmony, solidarity. With the approval of the project, work is expected to start next year.

#### **ELECTRIC PYLONS**

The installation of the electric pylons scheduled for last January is still to be done. Unfortunately, the health crisis has slowed down the bureaucratic process and the installation of two new points for the charging of electric cars has been postponed to 2021. The positioning of the two stations, however, remains unchanged, the Communal Administration has decided to keep them within the historic centre. Thus continues the choice of the Municipality of Penna San Giovanni to commit to projects and systems to protect the environment.
